Перед вами короткий срез полного пособия: две техники из девяти и по два тренировочных сета каждого типа заданий — с ключами, разборами и аудио, ровно в том виде, в каком они идут в полной версии. Ничего не упрощено и не сокращено: вы видите настоящий продукт, просто меньше по объёму.

Что в полной версии

- 309 страниц: 9 техник, таблица акцентов US / UK / CA / AU, шаблоны заметок
- 110 сетов и 490 заданий с аудио — 400 коротких реплик, 30 диалогов, 30 объявлений, 30 лекций
- Все записи по QR-коду прямо со страницы, полные транскрипты в приложении
- Чек-листы и типичные ошибки по каждому из четырёх типов заданий
- Список сигналов, которые нужно узнавать на слух, и план на четыре недели

Демо можно свободно пересылать и распечатывать. Если формат подойдёт — полная версия по ссылке в конце файла.

Listening на реальном экзамене

Секция адаптивная: сначала роутер на 7–11 минут, затем основной модуль на 18 минут. Всего около 47 заданий четырёх типов — от коротких реплик, на которые нужно выбрать ответ, до академической лекции с несколькими вопросами.

Каждая запись звучит один раз. Вопросы вы видите после прослушивания, а не до него, поэтому «прочитать вопросы заранее» — стратегия из прошлого формата, здесь она не работает. Работает другое: понимать структуру записи и записывать ключевое по ходу.

Дикторы говорят с разными акцентами — американским, британским, канадским, австралийским. Это не ошибка записи и не повышенная сложность: на реальном экзамене так задумано, и привыкать к этому нужно заранее.

Числа даны по официальной спецификации ETS для формата 2026 года. Записи звучат один раз, паузы между заданиями короткие — тренируйтесь в тех же условиях: без перемотки и без второго прослушивания.

Девять техник для Listening — первые 2

Первые три техники применяются до того, как прозвучит содержание, остальные — по ходу записи и после неё. Отрабатывайте по одной за занятие, обязательно с записями разных акцентов.

1 Первые секунды решают

По первым двум-трём секундам определите жанр: два голоса — диалог, один голос с обращением ко всем — объявление, один голос без обращения — лекция. Жанр сразу задаёт, что будет важным. В диалоге — проблема одного из говорящих и её решение. В объявлении — что меняется, где и когда. В лекции — главная идея и два-три её обоснования. Дальше вы слушаете не «всё подряд», а конкретные вещи.

Attention, all residents of Building C...

Обращение ко всем — объявление. Значит, ждём: что происходит, с какого числа, что нужно сделать слушателю.

2 Заметки: только существительные и цифры

Записывать предложения бесполезно — пока пишете, теряете следующую фразу. Пишите только опорные слова: существительные, числа, даты, имена. Используйте сокращения и стрелки. Задача заметок не в том, чтобы восстановить текст, а в том, чтобы удержать внимание и вернуть себе структуру, когда появится вопрос.

lab → moved, Wed, 3rd floor, bring ID

Четыре обрывка вместо трёх предложений. Этого хватает, чтобы ответить на любой вопрос по такому объявлению.

Listen and Choose a Response — Прослушайте и выберите ответ

Вы слышите короткую реплику или вопрос (на экране текста нет). Затем читаете четыре возможных ответа и выбираете самый уместный в этой ситуации.

СТРАТЕГИЯ EXAMBOOSTER

Слушайте не только слова, но и коммуникативную цель: это вопрос, просьба, приглашение? Уместный ответ реагирует именно на неё. Отвлекающие варианты цепляются за отдельное слово из реплики, но не отвечают по сути.

ПОРЯДОК ДЕЙСТВИЙ

1. Определите функцию реплики: просьба, жалоба, предложение, отказ, уточнение.
2. Отвечайте на действие, а не на слова.
3. Отсекайте варианты, которые просто повторяют слово из реплики.
4. Не задумывайтесь дольше пятнадцати секунд — заданий много, каждое стоит один балл.

ТИПИЧНЫЕ ОШИБКИ

- Выбирать вариант с знакомым словом из услышанной фразы.
- Отвечать на вопрос буквально, когда прозвучала вежливая просьба.
- Терять темп: одно долгое задание съедает три следующих.

СТРАТЕГИЯ EXAMBOOSTER

Диалог короткий, второго прослушивания нет: держите в голове два вопроса — кто эти люди и в чём суть просьбы или проблемы. Второй вопрос почти всегда не о факте, а о выводе: что имел в виду говорящий и что он сделает дальше. Разговорные обороты и сокращения здесь норма.

ПОРЯДОК ДЕЙСТВИЙ

1. Ведите заметки в две колонки — по одной на собеседника.
2. Поймите проблему в первых репликах: с неё начинается почти любой диалог.
3. Отметьте, кто что предложил и чем закончилось.
4. Следите за оценочными словами — по ним спрашивают об отношении.

ТИПИЧНЫЕ ОШИБКИ

- Смешивать реплики говорящих и путать, кто что сказал.
- Запоминать содержание, но упускать итог разговора.
- Игнорировать интонацию: сомнение и согласие звучат по-разному даже при одинаковых словах.

СТРАТЕГИЯ EXAMBOOSTER

Сначала уловите главное: о чём объявление и кого оно касается. Затем ловите конкретику — время, место, что именно нужно сделать. Цифры и указания в объявлениях обычно и становятся предметом вопросов, поэтому фиксируйте их сразу.

ПОРЯДОК ДЕЙСТВИЙ

1. Сразу записывайте числа: время, дату, номер помещения, срок.
2. Найдите, что именно меняется и с какого момента.
3. Отметьте, что требуется от слушателя — почти всегда об этом спрашивают.
4. Проверьте себя на созвучиях: fifteen и fifty, Tuesday и Thursday.

ТИПИЧНЫЕ ОШИБКИ

- Записывать цифру «потом» — к моменту вопроса её уже нет в памяти.
- Путать старое расписание с новым.
- Пропускать финальную фразу с инструкцией — она обычно и есть ответ на последний вопрос.

Professor: Today's lecture examines how gravity transforms a cold, quiet cloud of interstellar gas into a blazing new star, a process astronomers call star formation inside a collapsing molecular cloud.

Professor: Molecular clouds are vast, frigid reservoirs of hydrogen gas and dust that normally resist collapsing under their own gravity because internal gas pressure pushes outward strongly enough to balance it. Collapse begins only when some disturbance, perhaps a nearby supernova shockwave or a collision between clouds, compresses a region until its density crosses a critical threshold and gravity finally overwhelms that outward pressure.

Professor: As a dense fragment collapses inward, conservation of angular momentum makes it spin faster and flatten into a rotating disk, much like a skater who spins faster by pulling in her arms. Meanwhile, gravitational contraction squeezes and heats the material at the fragment's center, eventually forming a dense, glowing core known as a protostar.

Professor: The Orion Nebula offers a vivid, nearby example of this process in action. Infrared telescopes have revealed hundreds of protostellar cores glowing behind curtains of dust that block visible light entirely, showing astronomers a stellar nursery actively churning out new stars from the same collapsing molecular material.

Professor: A true star is born only once the protostar's core grows hot and dense enough to ignite nuclear fusion, the reaction that will power the star for millions or billions of years, while any leftover material in the surrounding disk may eventually clump together into planets.

Professor: This week we turn to a puzzle that seemed almost impossible thirty years ago: how do astronomers find planets orbiting stars trillions of kilometers away, when the planets themselves are far too faint to see directly?

Professor: The most productive technique is called the transit method. When a planet passes directly in front of its star from our viewpoint, it blocks a tiny fraction of the star's light, and telescopes like Kepler recorded that faint, repeating dip in brightness. The size of the dip tells astronomers roughly how large the planet is.

Professor: A second technique, the radial velocity method, works differently. A planet doesn't just orbit its star; the star also wobbles slightly around their shared center of mass, pulled by the planet's own gravity. That wobble stretches and compresses the star's light in a pattern called the Doppler shift, which spectrographs can detect even when no transit ever occurs.

Professor: Consider a hot Jupiter, a massive gas planet orbiting close to its star. Its transits produce a deep, easily measured dip in brightness, while its strong gravity produces a large, unmistakable wobble in the star's motion. That's why hot Jupiters were among the easiest exoplanets to confirm, with both methods agreeing on their existence independently.

Professor: Together, these two methods let astronomers estimate a planet's size from transits and its mass from radial velocity, and combining both figures reveals the planet's density, an early hint at whether a distant world might be rocky like Earth or gaseous like Jupiter.

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
